

# Membership Information

We have now reached the Board of Directors instituted cap of 750 memberships. New memberships in the Poulsbo Sportsman Club are no longer for sale. All applications for new membership are being placed on a first come first served waiting list and the checks are being returned to the applicant.

All 2011 memberships expire as of March 31, 2012. At that time past member renewal applications will be placed on the same first come first served waiting list noted above and the checks will be returned to the applicant.

However, current 2011 memberships may be renewed through March 31, 2012. Following are some things that will speed your renewal application process if they are followed. If not, then we must contact you and get these clarified or corrected before we can continue to process your application.

- \* Use the current 2012 application form.
- \* Read and fill out your application completely.
- \* Be sure to send a photo copy of your NRA card or the label off your magazine that shows your NRA membership expiration date.
- \* If you have a family membership, your spouse or companion must sign the form as well as any children living at home or in school who are over 18 years of age.
- \* Send the correct amount, and be sure to remember to sign the check.
- \* Please give us your phone numbers. If we need to ask you a question about your membership it is much easier to call you.

These mistakes/omissions happen on a routine basis and can significantly delay the processing of your membership or renewal application.

If you have not sent in your 2012 renewal application do so now. Please don't wait until the last week in March. If you let your 2011 membership expire, there is a good chance you will wind up on the waiting list for 2012.
