

PSC AFTER HOURS SHOOTING

After hours shooting is available seven days a week with exceptions listed below.

After hours shooting is a privilege for club members only, no guests or public shooters are allowed. There is no Range Officer on duty during afterhours shooting. All shooters must sign in on a new sign in sheet.

After hours shooters must be out the gate by 8:20 PM as the gate shuts down and will not operate until the next morning at 9:00 AM. Clean up your brass and shut off all range lights when you leave. The motion sensor lights in the parking area will shut off automatically.

A gate card is required to enter and leave club property for after hours shooting. If you are a member and want a gate card, you must attend the 1 hour range orientation class before a card will be issued. Also see using your gate card under club general information. Anyone violating club or range safety rules will lose there after hours shooting privilege.

WINTER AFTER HOURS SHOOTING

After hours shooting is available on the (15/25/50 yard) lighted pistol ranges only and begins and ends with standard time.

Shooting hours are from 4:00 PM to 8:00 PM Pacific Standard Time seven days a week.

Exceptions:

Tuesday meeting nights (board meeting last Tuesday and general meeting first Tuesday of each month). On these days all shooting must stop by 6:15 PM and we encourage you to attend the meetings.

SUMMER AFTER HOURS SHOOTING

After hours shooting on the pistol (15/25/50 yard) and rifle (100/200 yard) ranges begins and ends with daylight savings time.

Shooting hours are from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM Pacific Daylight Time seven days a week.

Exceptions:

Tuesday meeting nights (board meeting last Tuesday and general meeting first Tuesday of each month). On these days all shooting must stop by 6:15 PM and we encourage you to attend the meetings.
